INTERNATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS AND MASTERS' EXHIBITION- WORLD HAPKIDO FESTIVAL

International Championships and Masters' Exhibition- Multi- National Event(estimated participation from 30 countries) for all of the World Kido Federation/Hanminjok Hapkido Association members and affiliates through out the world. Don't miss this opportunity to visit Korea for the world class competition, training and cultural experience.

Championships- We anticipate over 1,500 competitors in four different categories: FORMS, SPARRING, WEAPONS, SELF-DEFENCE.(maybe expand into more categories) This is your chance to compete against world class martial artists from around the world.

Seminar/Intensive training- Special seminar with Grandmaster Seo, week-long intensive training with Master Scott.

Sightseeing Highlights- Come see the beautiful Korea and experience the people and the amazing culture.- Guided tour, Children focused tour, and plenty of time to explore as you would like

Seoul- Metropolitan Area: With a population of over 10.5 million, Seoul is by far South Korea's largest city and one of East Asia's financial and cultural epicenters. Great mixture of old and the new and a fascinating city to explore. Tourist attractions:

Gyeongbok-gung(경복궁,景福宮), Yulgukno (*subway Gyeongbokgung*). Seoul's grandest Joseon Dynasty-era palace and the seat of power for centuries before it was razed in 1592 by a Japanese invasion (and they did a repeat after 1910). This was the first palace used by the Joseon Dynasty. Large parts have now been restored and the vast grounds also house the **Joseon Palace Museum** and the **Korean Folk Museum**.

N Seoul Tower (Namsan Tower) (*Metro Line 2 or 3, Chungmuro stn*) Once the tallest tower in Asia, it has the best panoramic view in all of Seoul. Many Seoulites and visitors have visited the tower to catch a glimpse of the city's landscape while enjoying the nature of Namsan Mountain and a host of other attractive facilities. Owing to the tower's unique structure, the observatory section boasts spectacular views of the changing foliage throughout all seasons. N Seoul Tower was renovated in 2005 with a newly designed high tech multimedia. The tower can be reached on foot, by taxi or, on the south side, by cable car.

Myeong-dong is a massive shopping district. Myeong-dong Street is around 1km long and extends from Myeong-dong Subway Station (Seoul Subway Line No. 4) to Lotte Department Store at Euljiro. All kinds of brand name shops and department stores are clustered along the streets and alleyways. You can purchase various products such as clothes, shoes, and accessories.

Busan- The second largest city in Korea, beautiful coastal-port city. *Kuk Jae Market- Grandmaster Seo's school since 1970's currently owned and operated by Chief Master Lee Chun Duk is located in this district.* HaeUnDae Beach- Korea's largest and one of most scenic beaches. During peak summer time, this beach attracts over one million visitors per day.

Gyeong Ju - As the capital of the Silla Kingdom for almost a thousand years, Gyeongju preserves vast amount of significant and fascinating historical heritages. Along with Bulguksa Temple and Seokguram Grotto, the Gyeongju Historical District has been designated as a World Heritage by UNESCO. Due to the bountiful historical, natural and cultural attractions, this region has long been a major tourist destination in Korea.
